



CENTRAL POINT BEAR CREEK GREENWAY PARK DESIGN SURVEY

Following the September 2020 wildfire that devastated the Central Point section of the Bear Creek Greenway, the City of Central Point took a proactive approach to managing the area. We have implemented regular maintenance measures to minimize the risk of future fires and have increased police patrols to improve public safety. For the next step in the management process, the Central Point Parks Department has contracted with Scharen Design Studio to develop a park design for the area.

This particular section of the Greenway trail boasts several natural features, including Bear Creek, Elk Creek, Espy Pond, a wetland, and riparian areas. Preserving and restoring these natural spaces is a crucial objective of the park design. Simultaneously, the design aims to ensure public accessibility to these locations, allowing people to have direct and meaningful experiences of the area with outdoor education being an important element.

Additionally, we envision incorporating elements of active recreation into the new park. We are considering options such as a dog park, a natural playground, a pump track, a Frisbee golf course, or a mountain bike skills course. However, we do not wish to design this park in isolation. We value our resident's opinions and encourage each of you to contribute to the development of this new park. We expect this planning process to take a year to complete and there will be various opportunities along the way for public comment, including public meetings and open houses.

DISCOVER YOUR CENTRAL POINT PARKS & RECREATION FOUNDATION!

Central Point's Parks and Recreation Foundation is a 501(c)3 non-profit that supports Central Point Parks and Recreation Department projects and activities. While our City strongly supports our parks, sometimes extra financial help is needed to accomplish what our tax dollars cannot. The foundation exists to fill this need. Here are a few of the things that the Foundation has supported over the past year:

- Purchase of park signs and benches.
- The "Plant a Thousand Daffodils" program plant-

ed 7,000 daffodil bulbs in local parks using donations from individuals, businesses, and organizations.

• Starting Jan. 1, the foundation will launch a scholarship program ensuring that children and seniors are able to attend our recreation department's wonderful classes.

• The Central Point Cemetery is undergoing a renaissance with the assistance of a foundation standing committee whose first priority is to fund work to maintain the trees on the property.

• In partnership with the City and volunteers, the foundation will provide funds to design and plant a pollinator garden at Flanagan Park. We hope to plant similar gardens in other public sites throughout the city.



- We have replaced flags and other monument elements, at the War Memorial and helped purchased memorial plaques at the Richardson Memorial and at Bohnert Park.
- The foundation sponsors the "My Veterans/My Hero Tribute Tree Program" which provides opportunities to celebrate family members who have served honorably in the U.S. military.
- The Foundation enhances recreational activities & special events by providing supplies, prizes, and volunteer support. Our Board meets three to four times a

year with members participating in various events and activities. We are currently seeking volunteers to serve on the board. Please consider joining us! 


