NATURE OF MEETING

Beginning at the above time and place, the Central Point City Council will consider adoption of the Comprehensive Plan Parks and Recreation Element covering a twenty (20) year planning period, 2018-2038. The purpose of the Parks and Recreation Element is to guide City decision-making to ensure the parks and recreation system meets the needs of the Central Point Community. It addresses goals, policies and other management considerations toward the continuation of quality recreation opportunities and potential upgrades. The proposal reflects changes in the text, goals and policies since the last amendment of the Parks and Recreation Element in 1983. **Applicant/Agent: City of Central Point**.

Pursuant to ORS 197.763 (3) (e), failure to raise an issue during this hearing, in person or in writing, with sufficient specificity to afford the decision-makers and the parties an opportunity to respond to the issue will preclude an appeal based on that issue.

The Comprehensive Plan Amendment application is being reviewed using Type IV procedures in accordance with Section 17.05.500 of the Central Point Municipal Code (CPMC). Approval criteria for comprehensive plan amendments are set forth in the CPMC 17.96.
