 - Signature of the licensed surveyor attesting to the accuracy of information provided.

Property line adjustments and lot consolidations shall be surveyed, monumented and recorded per ORS 92.060(7) and 209.250. Prior to issuance of any building permits, a copy of the Jackson County Surveyor's approval verifying the above requirements shall be provided to the Planning Department along with a copy of the recorded map of survey and evidence that the revised deeds have been filed as necessary to complete the PLA, Lot Consolidation.

- □ Revised legal descriptions for the propose property line adjustment or lot consolidation.
- □ Title Report that lists the vested owner(s) and easement encumbrances for each property.
- Written consent of owner to act as Agent in application process (if applicable)

Note: If any wetlands exist on the site, it is the applicant's responsibility to apply for a permit to the Division of State Lands and Army Corps of Engineers before any site work begins.
