This correspondence serves as a **Notice of Decision** that on March 2, 2021 the Central Point Planning Commission, by Resolution No. 888 & 889 approved:

A Conditional Use Permit and Site Plan and Architectural Review application for the construction of a *Public Facility* for the City of Central Point Parks & Public Works Operations Center that includes approximately 25,259 square feet of building area, landscaping, and parking areas on 5.12 acres. The project site is located at 235 S. Haskell Street within the Transit Oriented Development (TOD) Corridor within the General Commercial (GC) zoning district and is identified on the Jackson County Assessor's map as 37S 2W 10AD, Tax Lots 700 & 798.

The approval of the Site Plan and Architectural Review is based on criteria and standards as set forth in the Central Point Municipal Code (CPMC) 17.67 & 17.72.
