- Having used any illegal drugs in the last 3 years (thirty-six months)
- Having used certain illegal drugs at any time (i.e. methamphetamine, cocaine, heroin, anabolic steroids, abuse/illegal use of prescription drugs, etc.)
- Having been arrested in the past*
- Having been released from probationary employment with another law enforcement agency*
- Having been terminated for cause from another law enforcement agency
- Having failed a background investigation for another law enforcement agency*
- Having been terminated for cause from any employment*
- Having a credit history that reflects poor decision making and irresponsibility*
- Having been found to be untruthful, deceptive or intentionally omitting essential information in any official proceeding and/or on any official document*
- Having been found to be untruthful, deceptive, or intentionally omitting information in any aspect of this recruitment process

*(*dependent on mitigating/aggravating circumstances discovered in or supported by the background check)*

The pre-employment background check is a comprehensive investigation into the character and conduct of the top candidate(s) after successfully passing all other phases of the selection process. The list above is not all inclusive of the information sought in the full background investigation. This list is merely an indication of the types of things that will automatically or likely bar you from further consideration as a candidate for Police Officer or Reserve Officer for the City of Central Point and is provided for your information only.
