A RESOLUTION SCHEDULING BIENNIAL ELECTION OF CENTRAL POINT CITY OFFICERS ON NOVEMBER 3, 2020


RECITALS:


- A. The Central Point City Charter provides that regular City elections shall be held at the same time and place as biennial general state elections, and the next biennial state election is scheduled for November 3, 2020;
- B. The biennial election of the City of Central Point, Oregon, shall be held concurrently with the general election of the State of Oregon on November 3, 2020, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. Pacific Standard Time, at which election the citizens shall elect one Mayor, council member from Ward IV, and two Council Members At-Large.
- C. The precincts and judges and clerks of election shall be the same as those provided within the City of Central Point, Oregon, for the statewide general election held on the same date.
- D. The City Recorder is hereby authorized and directed to give notice of said election by posting notice thereof in a conspicuous place in the City Hall and in one public place in each voting precinct of the City. The notice shall state the officers to be elected and the time and place of the election.
- E. All candidates for the offices mentioned in Section 1 above shall file the proper forms of nomination with the City Recorder during normal business hours between Monday, July 6, 2020, and Tuesday, August 25, 2020.

The City of Central Point resolves as follows:

Section 1. The Central Point City Charter provides that regular City elections shall be held at the same times and places as biennial general state elections, and the next biennial state election is scheduled for November 3, 2020;
