

RESOLUTION NO. 1756

**A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE POLICE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT and
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO SIGN THE AGREEMENT AND
UPDATED CLASSIFICATION PAY PLAN**

RECITALS:

1. The City of Central Point has a fundamental interest in the development of harmonious and cooperative relationships between the City and its employees; and
2. The City recognizes the rights of public employees to organize; and
3. The City recognizes and accepts that the principle and procedure of collective bargaining can alleviate various forms of strife and unrest; and
4. ORS 243 "Collective Bargaining" defines and outlines the policies involved in collective bargaining between public entities and public employers; and
5. The current police collective bargaining agreement expired on June 30, 2023; and
6. The successor bargaining agreement will be effective from July 1, 2023 – June 30, 2026.

The City of Central Point resolves as follows:


The Police Collective Bargaining Agreement between the City of Central Point and Teamsters Local 223 (Police), as attached, and the updated Classification Pay Plan are hereby ratified and adopted, and the Mayor and City Manager are authorized to sign the Agreement.
