Selection Criteria



- ◆ 14-21 years of age
- ◆ Must be a US Citizen
- ◆ Maintain "C" average (2.5 GPA)
- ◆ Must speak fluent English
- ◆ Willing to attend bi-weekly trainings and meetings.
- ◆ Must volunteer a minimum of 12 hours per month.
- ◆ Be of good moral character
- ◆ Have no felony or class A misdemeanor convictions
- ◆ Successfully pass an oral interview and background investigation
