 - must possess or obtain US citizenship per OAR 259-008-0010
- must not have any felony convictions or domestic violence convictions
 - must have an acceptable driving record
- must be able to pass physical (including hearing and visual) and psychological examinations
 - must be able to pass a drug and alcohol screen
- must be able to fully meet D.P.S.S.T. standard (OAR 259-008-0010) for employment as a law enforcement officer
